RECRUITMENT

Applicants will participate in a recruitment process led by the MCAS Director.

TERMS

Selected members will serve a one-year term from September 1, 2024 – August 31, 2025.

Selected members may have the option to stay for a staggered term lasting either one or two more years.

REIMBURSEMENT

Stipend payments for meetings and/or eligible reimbursement of costs to participate are available.

TIME COMMITMENT

Meetings will be held every other month for the first year. They are in-person at the Multnomah Building (501 S.E. Hawthorne Blvd. Portland, OR). A hybrid option will be available, though in-person attendance is highly encouraged.
